COMPETITION REGULATIONS

“#LUG Best Project Contest – Realisation - 2019”

Art. 1 General Provisions

1. The Regulations determine the rules, scope and terms and conditions of participation in the competition:
“#LUG Best Project Contest – Realisation - 2019”
2. The Competition Organizer is LUG LIGHT FACTORY Sp. z o.o. Company with its registered office in Zielona Góra at ul. Gorzowska 11, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register (KRS) under number 0000290498, District Court in Zielona Góra, 8th Commercial Division KRS, NIP (Tax Identification No.) 929-17-85-452, REGON (National Business Registry No.) 080212116, share capital: PLN 29,000,000, hereinafter referred to as the Organizer.
3. The Organizer is the Promising Entity within the meaning of Articles 919 and 921 of the Polish Civil Code.
4. The Competition will last **from 17 June 2019 to 31 December 2019.**
5. The objective of the Competition is the promotion of creative and innovative lighting solutions.
6. Participation in the Competition and providing related data is entirely voluntary and is tantamount to accepting the provisions of these Regulations.
7. Employees and representatives of the Organizer, as well as members of their immediate family, cannot participate in the Competition. The members of the immediate family shall be understood as ascendants, descendants, siblings, spouses, spouses of siblings, parents of spouses, and persons in adoption relationship.
8. By registering participation in the Competition, the Participant accepts the Regulations in their entirety and agrees to observe the rules specified therein, as well as confirms that s/he has read the Regulations, understands their contents and meets all the conditions that entitle him/her to participate in the Competition.

Art. 2 Conditions of Participation in the “#LUG Best Project Contest – Realisation - 2019” Competition

1. The Competition is open to natural persons or legal entities (assuming that the creator of the project will each time be a natural person or a team of such persons) who conduct activities in the field of architecture and interior design. Students of faculties related to architecture or interior design as well as graduates of these faculties are allowed to participate in the Competition.
2. The subject of the Competition is to prepare the design of any architectural object: building, interior or infrastructural facility (object lighting, illumination or street lighting), which is lit using luminaires by LUG LIGHT FACTORY Sp. z o.o., put into service not earlier than on 1 January 2018.
3. The Competition Work should consist of:
 - photo documentation of the realized investment illuminated using LUG luminaires - at least 3 photos in the minimum resolution of 300 dpi in a size similar to 3,500 x 2,500 pixels, any orientation preferred, format: jpg., png., tiff.
 - short description of the proposed solution, containing the following information: personal data of the design author and company name (if applicable),
4. The Competition Work should be prepared in electronic form and sent to the following address: marketing@lug.com.pl until 31 December 2019. In the message subject line please write **“#LUG Best Project Contest – Implementation - 2019”**

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5. By submitting the Work, the Participant declares that s/he is the author of the Work and the sole owner of the property and non-property copyrights to the Work. Any claims of third parties in the above mentioned scope shall be provided by the Organizer directly to the Contest Participant, who, together with the submission of the Competition Work, releases the Organizer from any liability in this scope. The Organizer reserves the right to reject the Work in case of any doubts concerning copyrights.
6. The Organizer reserves the right to acquire ownership of each of the awarded Competition Works, including all property copyrights to each of the awarded Competition Works. At the moment of awarding the prize to each of the Competition winners, the Organizer acquires from the winner receiving the prize, without additional remuneration over and above the prize provided for in these Regulations, the author's property copyrights to use the awarded Competition Work in the entire world, in all fields of exploitation referred to in Article 50 of the Act of 4 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights (Journal of Laws of 2000, No. 80, Item 904, as amended), including in the following fields: (i) in the field of recording and multiplying the Competition Work - production of copies of the Work using any technique, including printing, reprography, magnetic recording and digital technology, as well as production of a finished product on the basis of the submitted Work, including a product modelled on the Work taking into account the changes made by the Organizer; (ii) in the field of the distribution of the original or copies on which the Competition Work was recorded - marketing, lending or renting the original or copies; (iii) in the field of the distribution of the Competition Work in a manner other than specified in Item (ii) - public performance, exhibition, display, reproduction, broadcasting and reemission, as well as making the Work available to the public in such a way that everyone can access the Work at a place and at a time chosen by them. At the moment of awarding the prize, the Organizer also acquires the exclusive right to allow the performance of dependent copyrights to the awarded Competition Work. If the transfer of economic copyrights to the awarded Competition Work, within the scope specified above, would require additional factual or legal actions - the Competition winner shall immediately undertake such actions, without additional remuneration.
7. Irrespective of the provisions of Item 6 above, upon registration of participation in the Competition, each Competition Participant grants to the Organizer, without remuneration, an exclusive licence to use the submitted Competition Work in all fields of exploitation specified in Item 6 above.
8. Information about the Competition shall be published on the Organizer's website, in newsletters and in social media.

Art. 3 Competition Resolution and Prizes

1. The Competition shall be settled on 3 February 2020 by a 9-person jury.
2. The jury will evaluate the Works in four aspects:
 - a. Creativity,
 - b. Aesthetics,
 - c. Accuracy of LUG luminaires application,
 - d. Functionality.
3. The prizes are cash prizes in the following gross amounts:
 - A) I – EUR 4,000
 - B) II – EUR 2,600
 - C) III – EUR 1,900
4. From the amount of the Prize referred to in Item 3, a 10% flat-rate income tax shall be deducted, which the Competition Organizer shall transfer to the Tax Office.

If a natural person conducting business activity in the field of architecture and interior design in the territory of the Republic of Poland becomes the winner of the Competition, the tax may not be deducted if this person, prior to the awarding of the Prize, submits to the Competition Organizer a written statement that s/he is conducting business activity and participation in the Competition falls within the scope of his or her business activity. The Competition winner

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- conducting business activity is obliged to include the value of the Prize in his/her income from business activity.
- Prizes cannot be exchanged for any other goods.
 - The Organizer reserves the right to refuse to grant the Prize in the event of the winner's failure to comply with the obligations arising from Article 2.

 - The result of the Competition is one-off and is announced on 3 February 2020.
 - Prizes will be handed over to the winners by the Organizer within 20 working days from the date of the competition resolution.

Art. 4 Complaints

- Complaints should be submitted in writing and sent by registered mail to the address of the Organizer's registered office, within 7 days of the end of the Competition at the latest,

and, in the case of the prizes awarded, within 7 days of receipt of the prize. Complaints submitted after the above deadline shall not be accepted.
- Complaints must be submitted in writing or otherwise they shall be null and void.
- Complaints shall be considered within 14 days from the date of their receipt.
- The right to lodge a complaint is vested only in the Competition Participant.
- The Organizer shall inform the person lodging the complaint about the result of the complaint by registered mail to the address specified in the complaint.

Art. 5 Personal Data

- The personal data collector is LUG Light Factory Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Zielona Góra (65-127) at ul. Gorzowska 11, and the data may be transferred to other entities from the LUG Capital Group and to the co-organizers and partners of the Competition.
- The processing of personal data shall be carried out in order to (i) conduct the Competition, select the winners and prove the fulfilment of the obligations incumbent on the Organizer - the basis for such processing is the necessity to realize the legitimate interest of the controller, where the legitimate interest of the controller is to conduct the Competition and the possibility to claim damages and defend against claims (Article 6.1(f) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC - General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter: "GDPR"), (ii) fulfil the obligations related to the Competition, in particular awarding prizes and making legal and tax settlements - the legal basis for processing is the necessity to fulfil the Organizers' legal obligation to award prizes to the winners of the Competition and make legal and tax settlements (Article 6.1(c) of the Regulation).
- Providing personal data is voluntary yet necessary to participate in the Competition.
- The Competition Participant allows the use of his/her name to inform (also in social media) about the results of the Competition.
- The personal data provided shall be processed until the expiry of all claims related to the Competition.
- A Participant may request the data controller to grant access to the Participant's personal data in order to correct, delete or limit the processing of such data by e-mail: dane.osobowe@lug.com.pl.
- Participants are also entitled to transfer data (if technically possible), object to the processing on the basis specified in Article 5.2(i)), and lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority - on the



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date of announcing the Competition, i.e. to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.

Art. 6 Final Provisions

1. Any disputes arising from the performance of obligations related to this Promotion shall be settled by the court of local jurisdiction for the seat of the Organiser in accordance with the Polish law. The Participant may refer the matter to court after the complaint procedure has been exhausted.
2. In matters not regulated by these conditions of participation, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply.

4. The provisions of these conditions of participation constitute the sole basis for conducting the Competition, and their interpretation depends solely on the Organizer. All promotional and advertising materials are for informational purposes only. The image of prizes possibly presented in advertising materials may differ from their actual appearance.
5. Any rights of the Participant resulting from these Regulations are not transferable to third parties.
6. All other public and legal obligations, including tax obligations, shall be borne by the winner.
7. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel the Competition, to divide the prizes in any other way or not to award the prize without giving any reason.
